### WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE DRAFT PLAN?


The North Shore Neighbourhood Plan is an update to the 2008 plan of the same name. Its purpose is to provide direction for land use planning on the North Shore. It includes a community vision, policies to guide decision-making by City staff and Council, and ideas described as "Big Moves", which can help to achieve the vision.

#### **COMMUNITY VISION**

Working with Kamloops residents, a vision was created, which describes the North Shore as an inclusive, dynamic, and complete community that provides a high quality of life for every resident.

## **POLICIES | TOPIC AREAS**

The draft plan includes a number of policies organized by topic and character areas. Topic area policies include:

#### **Transportation & Mobility**

To create a transportation network on the North Shore that is sustainable, safe, accessible, and efficient.

#### **Infrastructure & Environment**

To manage infrastructure sustainably and efficiently to address the needs of future residents and mitigate impacts on the environment.

#### Housing

To encourage an adequate and diverse supply of affordable, safe, accessible, and appropriate housing to meet the needs of residents.

#### Parks & Public Places

To provide a diverse and well-connected network of public recreational spaces.

#### Arts, Culture, and Heritage

To build on and celebrate the North Shore's vibrant and eclectic arts community and history.

#### **Economic Development**

To enhance and expand the diversity of the North Shore's economy; attract private investment; and promote tourism-oriented businesses, services, and events.

#### **Health & Safety**

To foster a healthy and active community where residents and visitors of all ages feel safe, supported, and secure.

#### **Food Security**

To support a local food system that enhances community health, resiliency, and economic development.



#### **BIG MOVES**

The big moves are conceptual ideas to help create a more inclusive, dynamic, and complete North Shore. The big moves include key redevelopment areas (#1-3), new housing opportunities (#4-6), and catalyst projects (#7-10). If these projects became a reality, they could help improve the North Shore by providing additional housing and commercial spaces; public gathering places; and safer, accessible connectivity for pedestrians.

#### **IMPLEMENTATION**

To implement the plan, a list of 30 short-, medium-, and long-term actions have been identified to support the vision, policies, and big moves. Implementation will occur over the 20-year life of the plan and will require a combined City, community, and private sector effort to achieve.
